Tangulia Camp in the Masai Mara



Tanguila Camp is a traditional safari camp built on a rocky hill with a thatched and open fronted building, overlooking the Olotulo Murt Salt Lick, frequented by wildlife, and which leads down to the Mara River.

Situated on private land on the western boundary of the Mara Reserve, allowing easy access to game drive around the Musiara Marsh, the short grass plains, and Rhino Ridge, in the Reserve; or across the Mara River bridge into the Mara Triangle west of the river.

Both areas have rich biodiversity and offer prime birdlife, plains game and big cat viewing; and, during the migration, ready access to some of the main river-crossing places.







WITH YOUR SECOND HOST...

Jackson Looseyia - BBC Big Cat Live's only Masai presenter, conservationist and Kenya's top safari guide





Jackson Ole Looseyia is one of the best wildlife guides in Africa. He grew up surrounded by wildlife and from an early age found it a source of inspiration. Tracking animals is in his blood – he comes from a long line of hunters & trackers.

He has an extraordinary life-story. After spending his childhood hunting illegally, the arrest and then death of his father and the responsibility of his family handed down to him, Jackson went on to become one of the first guides of the Masai Mara. Jackson is a true ambassador, expressing modern conservation ideas to Maasai communities and explaining Maasai values to travellers, always with eloquence and humour!

His love of all creatures, his respect for nature and his Maasai traditions make Jackson and exceptional safari guide. He knows every mound, bush and river. Little wonder that he was brought in to enhance the popular BBC series Big Cat Live'. Olive and her leopard family were even named after him – 'The Jackson Five'.

Mike's Camp on Kiwayu Island



Kiwayu Island is one of the many unspoilt, idyllic islands of the Lamu Archipelago, on the Kenya Coast. Mikes Camp is home for the next four nights and is probably the only Robinson Crusoe Lodge in Kenya and is hours away from 21st Century life! Mike's is an Eco Camp where water is brought by donkey and power comes from the wind and the sun. The seven private and spacious bandas are set amongst the sand dunes, with panoramic views.
